Itinerary

Thursday, October 24, - Board your flight out of the Colorado Springs Airport where we will fly to Dallas Fort Worth and then change planes and fly to Springfield-Branson National Airport. We will be met at the Airport by our Transportation Company and board onto our Luxury Coach and then head to Branson. On the way we will stop at Lambert's Café, the home of the throwed rolls. Dinner is included in the package. After dinner we will roll into Branson and settle into the Thousand Hills Resort Hotel.

Friday, October 25, - A Hot Breakfast awaits you in the dining room, and then we will load on the bus for a Down Home Country Show & Lunch at the Grand Country Music Hall. We will get back on the bus and depart for beautiful Eureka Springs, AR. You will have plenty of time for a "nap" or to admire the grand scenery as we make our way to Americas #1 Attended Outdoor Drama "The Great Passion Play". Once we arrive, we have an opportunity to enjoy a backstage tour, enjoy an all you can eat buffet of pulled pork, BBQ ribs, baked chicken, Salisbury steak, meatloaf and all the fixings, (including dessert). The outdoor play will follow and present the life, death and resurrection and ascension of Jesus Christ.

All shows and meals for Friday are included in your package.

We will visit a Veterans Memorial Garden, built by students, a dairy farm/barn where students learn to

milk cows and make cheese, we will visit onsite museums, a candle shop, sewing shop and then we will have dinner in the award-winning dining hall.

Wait! There's more... We will hop on the Bus and head over to the Clay Cooper Theatre for an evening with the Haygoods. Billed as Branson's Most Popular Show – This Family act has incredible music, and amazing special effects.

Sunday, October 27, A Hot Breakfast awaits you in the dining room. This morning, we are headed to the Dogwood Canyon Nature Park for a Wildlife Tour. An Open-Air Tram will take you past towering bluffs, breathtaking waterfalls and crossing creek beds by beautifully crafted stone bridges. We will cross the state line to Arkansas and if the time is right will see Bison and other wildlife. We will get back on the bus and head back to Branson and visit "The Landing", an outdoor shopping area with over 100 specialty shops, over 18 restaurants, bars, and coffee shops where you may choose to have lunch on your own. (not included in package). Back on the Bus and we are off the The Pepsi Legends Theatre for a "Legends in Concert". After the show we are headed to the Heros Taste and Taps for a quick bite to eat, enjoy Fried Fish, Meatloaf, or Farmhouse roasted Chicken with all the extras and then back to the Clay Cooper Theatre for the "Clay Cooper Country Express". This show was the favorite of all the shows the last time we were in Branson.

Everything on Sunday is included in the package except for your lunch.

Monday, October 28th, A Hot Breakfast awaits you in the dining room. Pack the Bus and we are headed back to the Springfield-Branson National Airport.

Some additional Information

We will be flying on American Airlines – Tentatively we will be departing Colorado Springs on the 24th of October at 1:02 pm and arriving in Springfield-Branson at 6:03 pm. (There is less than a hour layover in Dallas Forth Worth to change planes). The return flight will leave Springfield-Branson on the 28th at 10:00 am and arrive at Colorado Springs at 3:40 pm. Luggage fees are not included in the ticket price, and I would plan on \$40-\$45 per piece of luggage. American Airlines does allow 1 carry on piece per person.

All meals and meals gratuities (except for the Sunday lunch) are included in the package price. Sunday lunch will be on your own. A housekeeping gratuity will be at your discretion. If you feel so inclined to tip the transportation driver you may do so on Monday when he drops us off at the Springfield- Branson Airport.

If you have any food allergies, please let us know when making your reservations. We want to make sure that there are choices for the meals that for everyone. This includes allergies to dairy, fish, wheat, etc.

No Alcoholic drinks are included in the package prices. If you choose to have some alcohol, please do so responsibly.
